HIDDEN GEMS



1. Search Settings

Teachers can use the search to quickly find the specific symbols they need, or they can browse by category for a range of results.

Example categories: "adult," "American Sign Language," "actions," DOLCH sight words, and academic subjects

2. Change Skin Tone

Help students feel culturally represented by choosing a similar skin tone for SymbolStix people who appear in various symbols. Teachers can set a universal default with just one click, saving the time and trouble of making manual changes.

Examples: Choose from five different skin tones

3. Multiple Languages

Connect with English language learners (ELLs) by changing the language of the words that pair with symbols. Parents whose first language isn't English can make their voices heard via their native language.

Examples: Spanish, French, Dutch, and German (11 languages total)

4. My Boards Organization

Teachers can quickly find their saved boards using filtering and grouping options in My Boards.

Examples: Filters include recent, alphabetical order, and favorited. My Folders grouping includes subject areas and communication boards

5. Multiple Page Boards

Teachers have greater flexibility to meet individual student needs since each page can be a different board type. Plus, students get the support they need to communicate better and excel in the classroom.

Example: Create class books and make multipage communication boards

6. Sharing Boards

Promote student success by giving the IEP team the resources to provide consistency across environments and people. Share boards with subscribers (search for their username in SymbolStix PRIME) and with non-subscribers (enter their email address).

Examples: Share boards with school service providers, general education teachers, families, and outside therapists

7. Interactive Tools

Students can communicate and participate in learning using tools in an interactive document assigned to them as well as during whole-group instruction with a document on an interactive whiteboard.

Examples: pen (different colors), highlighter, and eraser
