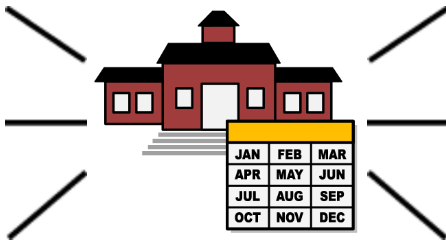
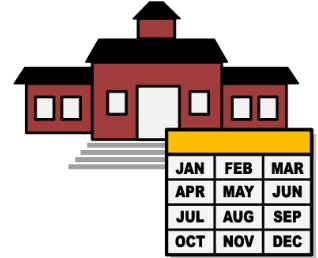

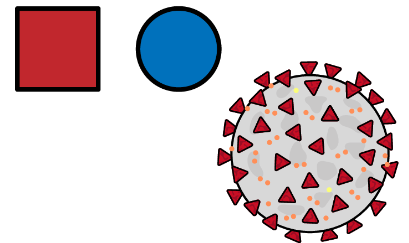

A new school year starts soon in the U.S.

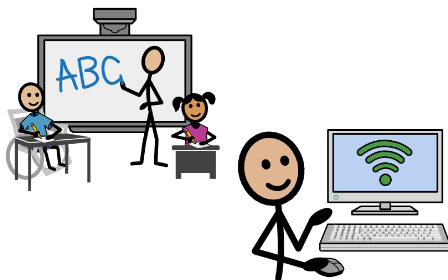
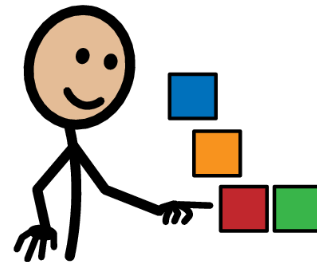
This school year may be different because of the coronavirus. The coronavirus spreads from person to person. School leaders do not want it to spread in schools.



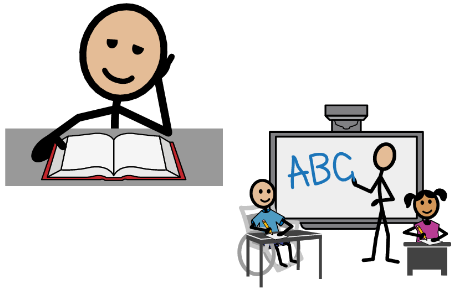


School leaders want to keep students and teachers healthy. They want students to learn too.

School leaders are making decisions for their schools.

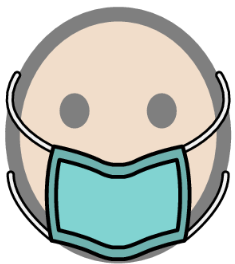
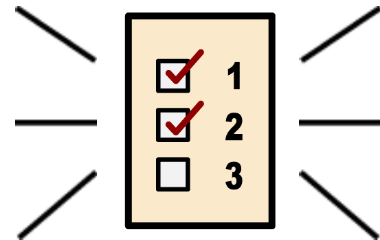


Some school leaders want students to learn in classrooms. Some school leaders want students to learn online.

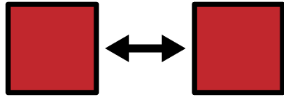


Some students will learn in classrooms this school year. But being in classrooms may be different.

Schools may have new rules to keep students healthy.

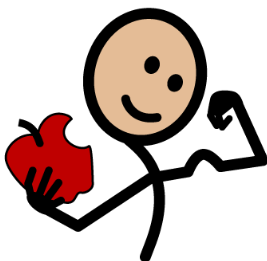
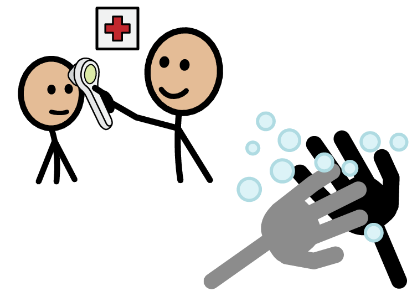


Students may need to wear face masks. Teachers may need to wear face masks too.

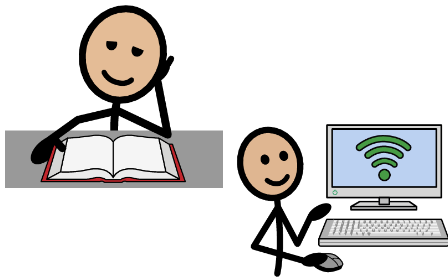


Students may sit farther apart in classrooms. They may not go to shared spaces like gyms.

Students may have their temperatures checked. They may need to wash their hands more often.

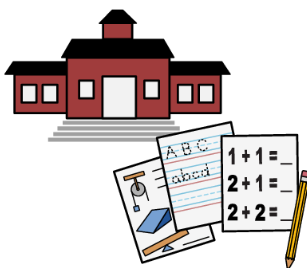
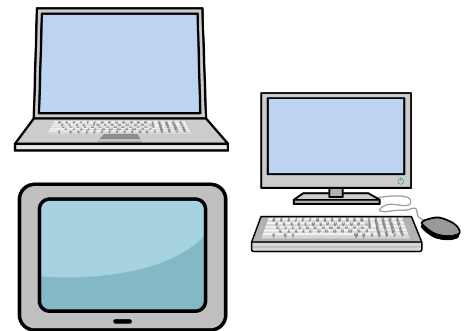


School leaders hope the new rules keep everyone healthy.

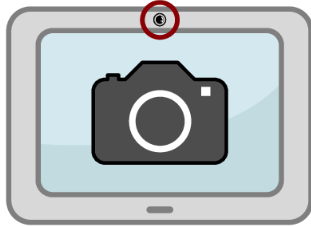


Some students will learn online this school year. Many of these students will learn at home.

These students may use laptops, tablets or computers.

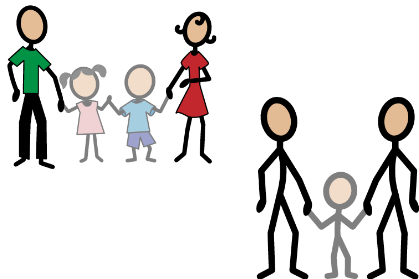
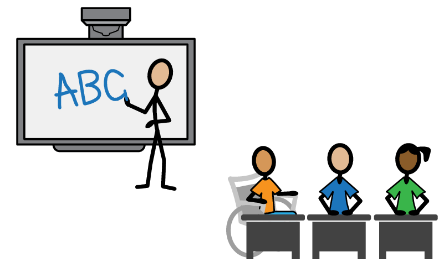


Teachers will send schoolwork to students.

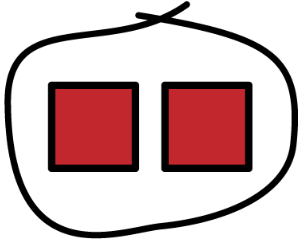


Students may have classes online. They may use cameras to see each other.

Students may see their teachers and classmates online. They may talk to each other online too.

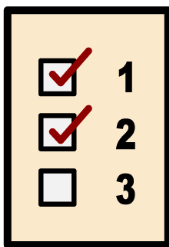
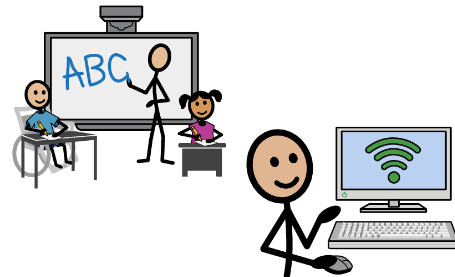


Parents and caregivers may help students learn online.

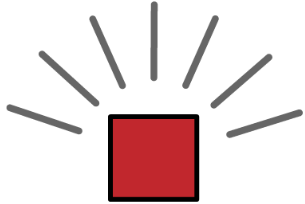


Some students will learn both in classrooms and online.

Many school leaders work in schools. Many school leaders work with students.



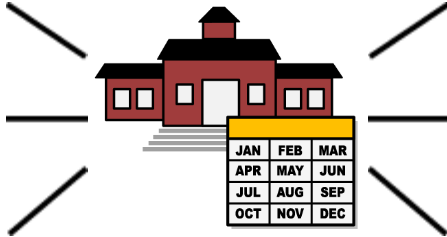
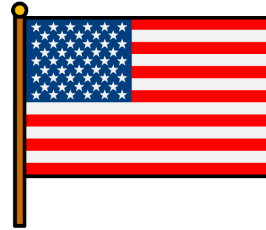
